



The Great Receipt Race 2020 Competition Rules

1. Participants are required to text a picture of their receipt to the phone number provided by REV Birmingham.
2. Phone numbers are the participants' unique identifier. Email or any other method of proving purchase will not qualify.
3. Receipts or proof of purchase must include name of business, business address, and total cost of purchase to qualify.
4. Receipts or proof of purchase must be from a qualified business. Qualified businesses will be defined as:
 - a. A business located in the Birmingham City Limits;
 - b. A business that is locally owned (no nationally franchised businesses);
 - c. REV Birmingham holds the ultimate right to determine if a business is qualified for The Great Receipt Race.
5. Participants are allowed to play only one phone number per person.
6. Participants are allowed only one prize per phone number.
7. Participants are required to provide proof of their voucher when claiming a prize.
8. REV Birmingham makes no assurances that every qualifying participant will be awarded a prize.
9. Prizes are available while supplies last.
10. Awards will be determined by a raffle style drawing. Participants will have their unique identifier entered into the drawing to reflect the number of receipts submitted that week. Weekly winners will be awarded gift card(s) that total \$100. The winner may select up to four local businesses to split the \$100 gift card prize.
 - a. For the sake of this competition, a week will be defined as seven days from Monday to Sunday.
 - b. Receipts must be submitted by Sunday at midnight to count toward the weekly raffle drawing. Receipts not submitted by Sunday at midnight, will not be entered into the weekly raffle drawing.
